ABNORMAL VITAL SIGNS AND SHOCK

Presentations may involve almost any condition with a substantial physiologic effect, as well as shock from any pathophysiologic origin. This topic has broad application in other MyEMCert modules and is germane to many medical conditions.

Examples of specific conditions may include sepsis, fever, third-degree heart block, beta-blocker overdose, preeclampsia, hyperkalemia, and hemodynamically unstable dysrhythmias.
